

About Us

Stirling Ministries is a Pennsylvania non-profit organization completely dedicated to Jesus Christ and His mission; the mission He gave to every believer ... to go into the whole world and make disciples.

The organization was founded in early 2012 by Rev. Craig Stirling and Yadith Stirling out of the passion that God has given them for Central and South America. Currently they are working in Colombia.

There are various areas in which Stirling Ministries functions; below are listed some of these areas (see the website for more information):

- Create, develop, and fund home and international missions projects
- Lead missions teams on a short term basis
- Church planting in Central and South America
- Provide for physical, spiritual, and emotional needs of the less fortunate
- Working with single mothers and children
- Teaching and training pastors and leaders

Project "Manna"

In Exodus we read that God provided food for the Israelites in the desert. In the morning they would go out and pick up this divine manna, and it would sustain them. It is appropriate then to call this project "Manna" as God has placed it on our hearts to provide for the needs of children in Charalá and surrounding areas. There is a list with the names of several hundred children on it who cannot afford to eat lunch, the main meal of the day in Colombia; this project will address this need.

Phase I of this project will include purchasing a building in which we can provide food for these children while being in a Christian environment. Phase II will incorporate the teaching of trades to single mothers, allowing them to support their families. Finally, phase III will

open the restaurant to the public during hours that it is not in use for the children. In this way it will provide income, and will become fully self-sustaining.

The cost to complete the project is \$80,000; however, we will be able to begin with \$35,000. It seems like a lot to raise, yet when it is broken down, that means that 35 people each giving \$1,000 or 350 people each giving \$100 could start it.
